## New Supportive Housing: Vancouver

Supportive Housing is affordable housing that connects individuals with the supports they need to stabilize and rebuild their lives. Supports can include mental health, addictions and medical services, income supports, as well as education, training and life skills programs. The level of support varies and can be delivered by on-site staff or through outreach.

The province has a partnership with the City of Vancouver to build more than 1,500 new supportive housing units in the city for those who are homeless or at risk of homelessness. Approximately 570 of the units are scheduled for completion by the end of 2011. The province is investing more than \$300 million and the city contributed the 14 parcels of land that are valued at \$64 million.

In May 2010, Streethome Foundation became a partner in 8 of the new developments (1006 units) and committed to fundraise \$20 million.
