<u>Introduction</u>

The Tenant filed an application to cancel a Notice to End Tenancy. The Landlords appeared and stated that the Tenant has already been served an Order, effective from today's date, to vacate the rental unit. As the Tenant did not appear at today's proceedings no hearing was held and the Tenants' application is dismissed without leave to reapply.
