Introduction

A substantial amount of documentary evidence and written arguments has been submitted prior to the hearing. I have thoroughly reviewed all submissions.

I also gave the applicant the opportunity to testify at the hearing.

The respondent was served with notice of the hearing by registered mail that was mailed on April 28, 2009 but did not join the conference call that was set up for the hearing.

All testimony was taken under affirmation.

Issues(s) to be Decided

This is a request for an Order of Possession and for an order for the respondent to pay \$1660.00 to the applicant. The applicant is also requesting an order for the respondent to bear the \$50.00 cost of the filing fee paid for this hearing.

Decisions and reasons

The landlord(s) had applied for an order of possession however at the time of the hearing the tenant had already vacated and the landlord had possession of the rental unit and therefore an order of possession is no longer needed. However rent in the amount of \$1510.00 is still outstanding to the end of May 2009.



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I therefore Order pursuant to Section 67 that the respondent(s) pay to the applicant(s) the sum of:

Outstanding rent	\$1510.00
Late fees \$25.00 X 3	\$75.00
NSF check fees \$25.00 X 3	\$75.00
Filing fee	\$50.00
Total	\$1710.00
