Background and Analysis

This hearing dealt with the tenant's application for return of her security deposit and recovery of the filing fee. Both parties participated in the hearing and the tenant reported that the dispute had been resolved between them prior to the hearing. In summary, it appears there was some misunderstanding and / or some miscommunication between the parties around the end of tenancy that resulted in a delay in the tenant's receipt of her security deposit. In the result, however, the tenant received a portion of her original security deposit which she considered to be fair and withdrew her application for dispute resolution.
