### **DECISION**

#### **Introduction**

Some written arguments have been submitted prior to the hearing. I have thoroughly reviewed all submissions.

I also gave the parties the opportunity to give their evidence orally and the parties were given the opportunity to ask questions of the other parties.

All testimony was taken under affirmation.

#### Decision and reasons

The tenant has applied for the return of the security deposit double; however the tenant has not met the burden of proving that she gave the landlord(s) a forwarding address in writing, as required by the Residential Tenancy Act, prior to applying for dispute resolution.

The burden of proving a claim lies with the person making the claim and when it is just that person's word against the word of the other, that burden of proof is not met. The applicant claims that she handed a forwarding address in writing to the landlord; however the landlords deny ever receiving a forwarding address from the tenant.

Therefore in the absence of any proof that a forwarding address in writing was given to the landlords, it is my finding that, at the time that the tenant(s) applied for dispute resolution, the landlord(s) were under no obligation to return the security deposit and therefore this application is premature.
