DECISION

<u>Introduction</u>

This matter dealt with an application by the Landlord for an Order of Possession and a Monetary Order for unpaid rent and for compensation for damages to the rental unit. The Landlord also applied to keep the Tenants' security deposit.

The hearing started at 1:30 p.m. as scheduled, however by 1:40 p.m. neither Party had dialled into the conference call. As there has been no hearing into the merits of the Landlord's application, it is dismissed with leave to reapply.

Conclusion

The Landlord's application is dismissed with leave to reapply. This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
