DECISION

<u>Introduction</u>

This is the Tenant's application to cancel a Notice to End Tenancy for Unpaid Rent and

to cancel a Notice to End Tenancy for Cause.

I reviewed the evidence provided prior to the Hearing. The parties gave affirmed

testimony and the Hearing proceeded on its merits.

Preliminary Matter

The Notice to End Tenancy, issued September 28, 2009, is not a valid Notice under

Sections 39 or 40 of the Act and would have been cancelled. The Notice consists of

page one of a 10 day Notice to End Tenancy for Unpaid Rent and page 2 of a One

Month Notice to End Tenancy for Cause. In any event, at the onset of the Hearing, the

parties stated that the Tenant had entered into a new tenancy agreement with the

Landlord on September 29, 2009. Therefore, the Tenant's application is granted. The

Tenancy remains in full force and effect.

Conclusion

The Tenant's application is granted. The tenancy remains in full force and effect.
