Introduction

Some documentary evidence and written arguments has been submitted prior to the hearing. I have thoroughly reviewed all submissions.

I also gave the applicant the opportunity to testify at the hearing.

The respondent was served with notice of the hearing by registered mail that was mailed on November 26, 2009, but did not join the conference call that was set up for the hearing.

All testimony was taken under affirmation.

Issues(s) to be Decided

This is a request for an Order of Possession based on Notice to End Tenancy for non-payment of rent and a request for outstanding rent totalling \$1100.00. The applicant is also requesting that the respondent pay the \$50.00 cost of the filing fee that was paid for this hearing

Decision and reasons

The tenant(s) have failed to comply with a Notice to End Tenancy and rent in the amount of \$800.00 is still outstanding.



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Therefore, pursuant to Section 55, I have issued an order of possession for two days after service on the respondent.

The landlord(s) is given a formal Order of Possession to serve on the tenant.

I further Order pursuant to Section 67 that the respondent(s) pay to the applicant(s) the sum of:

Outstanding rent	\$800.00
Total	\$850.00
