<u>Introduction</u>

This hearing proceeded by way of Direct Request Proceeding, pursuant to section

74(2)(b) of the Residential Tenancy Act (the Act).

**Preliminary Matter** 

The Landlord sought an Order of Possession based on a Notice to End Tenancy issued

October 1, 2009, and to recover the cost of the filing fee from the Tenants. This same

Notice to End Tenancy was the subject of an earlier participatory hearing on November

19, 2009. The Dispute Resolution Officer dismissed the Landlord's claim, as the Notice

was found to be of no force or effect.

The Landlord is at liberty to issue a new Notice to End Tenancy for Unpaid rent, should

they desire, and to make application for an Order of Possession based on that Notice in

accordance with the provisions of the Act.

Conclusion

The Landlord's application is dismissed as it has already been decided.
