DECISION

Dispute Codes OPC, CNC, FF

This decision deals with two applications for dispute resolution, one brought by the

tenant asking to have a Notice to End Tenancy canceled and requesting that the

landlord bear the \$50.00 cost of the filing fee they paid for their application for dispute

resolution, and one brought by the landlords requesting an Order of Possession based

on the Notice to End Tenancy.

<u>Conclusion</u>

No hearing was held because, at the hearing, the tenants stated that they have already

vacated the rental unit and therefore no longer request an order to have the Notice to

End Tenancy cancelled, and the landlord confirmed that they do have possession of the

rental unit and therefore they no longer need an Order of Possession.

I therefore making orders regarding possession of the rental unit, however since the

tenants vacated the rental unit before the date of the hearing is my decision that they

must bear the \$50.00 cost of the filing fee which they paid for their application for

dispute resolution.
