DECISION

<u>Introduction</u>

This matter dealt with an application by the Tenants to cancel a One Month Notice to End Tenancy for Cause dated June 18, 2010 and to recover the filing fee for this proceeding.

The hearing started at 1:30 p.m. as scheduled, however by 1:40 p.m., the Tenants had not dialled into the conference call. In the absence of any evidence from the Tenants to support their application, it is dismissed. Given also that the time limits for applying to cancel a Notice to End Tenancy under s. 47(4) and s. 66(3) of the Act have now expired, the Tenants' application is dismissed without leave to reapply.

The Landlord did not request any Orders at the hearing.

Conclusion

The Tenants' application is dismissed without leave to reapply. This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
