Decision & Reasons

No hearing was held because even though I waited until well past the time at which the hearing was to start, the applicant did not join the conference call that was set up for the hearing.

Conclusion

I therefore dismiss this application without leave to re-apply and at the request of the landlord I have issued an Order of Possession that is enforceable 2 days after service on the tenant.

The filing fee for this application had been previously waived, however since the applicant did not appear for the hearing I order that the applicant repay the \$50.00 filing fee to the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch.
