<u>Introduction</u>
This hearing was convened in response to the Tenant's Application for Dispute Resolution, in which the Tenant has applied to set aside a Notice to End Tenancy for Cause.
Both parties were represented at the hearing.
With the consent of both parties the correct spelling of the Landlord's name appears on this decision, although it was spelled incorrectly on the Application for Dispute Resolution.
Background and Evidence
At the outset of the hearing the Tenant stated that she was vacating the rental unit and was withdrawing her Application for Dispute Resolution. The Landlord did not oppose the Tenant's request to withdraw the Notice to End Tenancy.
