<u>Introduction</u>

This matter was set for hearing at 9:00 a.m. on this date to hear the tenant's application seeking to have a 1 month Notice to End Tenancy for Cause set aside. The landlord appeared for the hearing at the schedule time; however, the tenant failed to appear by 9:15 a.m.

At the landlord's requested that I amend the tenant's application to remove one of the respondents named in this proceeding. The landlord submitted that he is the one who entered into a tenancy agreement with the tenant. The landlord stated that he is a tenant renting to a sub-tenant and the other party identified in the application is his landlord and should not be a party to this dispute resolution proceeding.

I have amended the application.

Conclusion

Since the applicant did not appear at the hearing, but the respondent did appear and was ready to proceed, I dismissed the tenant's application without leave to reapply.
