<u>Introduction</u>

This matter dealt with an application by the Landlord to keep the Tenants' security deposit and to recover the filing fee for this proceeding.

This oral hearing via teleconference started at 9:00 a.m. as scheduled however by 9:10 a.m. neither party had dialled into the conference call. As there has been no hearing into the merits of the Landlord's application to keep the Tenants' security deposit, it is dismissed with leave to reapply. The Landlord's application to recover the filing fee for this proceeding however is dismissed without leave to reapply.

The Landlord's application to keep the Tenants' security deposit is dismissed with leave to reapply. The Landlord's application to recover the filing fee for this proceeding is dismissed without leave to reapply.
