DECISION

Introduction

This matter dealt with an application by the Landlord for a Monetary Order for unpaid utilities, for compensation for damages to the rental unit, to recover the filing fee for this proceeding and to keep the Tenants' security deposit in partial payment of those amounts.

The oral hearing via teleconference started at 9:00 a.m. as scheduled however by 9:10 a.m. neither party had dialled into the conference call. As there has been no hearing into the merits of the Landlord's application, it is dismissed with leave to reapply.

Conclusion

The Landlord's application is dismissed with leave to reapply. This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
