Introduction

This hearing dealt with the landlord's Application for Dispute Resolution seeking a monetary order.

The hearing was conducted via teleconference and was attended by the landlord's agent and the tenant.

Issue(s) to be Decided

The issues to be decided are whether the landlord is entitled to a monetary order for damages or losses; for all or part of the security deposit and to recover the filing fee from the tenant for the cost of the Application for Dispute Resolution, pursuant to Sections 38, 67, and 72 of the *Residential Tenancy Act (Act)*.

Background and Evidence

During the hearing the parties came to the following settlement agreement.

- 1. The landlord withdraws his Application for Dispute Resolution; and
- 2. The tenant agrees the landlord may retain the full security deposit.

Conclusion

As a result of the settlement agreement the parties accept these matters are settled in full.
