DECISION

<u>Dispute Codes</u> MNDC, MNSD, FF

Introduction

This hearing dealt with the tenant's Application for Dispute Resolution seeking a monetary order.

The hearing was conducted via teleconference and was attended by the tenant only. The landlord did not attend.

The tenant testified she had sent the landlord notice of this hearing via registered mail but could not provide a tracking number as confirmation or the specific date she mailed the hearing documents.

Issue(s) to be Decided

The issues to be decided are whether the tenant is entitled to a monetary order for compensation for unreleased personal items; for all or part of the security deposit and to recover the filing fee from the landlord for the cost of the Application for Dispute Resolution, pursuant to Sections 67, and 72 of the Residential Tenancy Act (Act).

Conclusion

As the tenant has failed to provide confirmation of service of notice of this hearing, I dismiss this Application with leave to reapply.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
