DECISION

<u>Dispute Codes</u> OPB, OPL, MNDC, FF

Introduction

This hearing dealt with the landlord's Application for Dispute Resolution seeking an order of possession and a monetary order.

The hearing was conducted via teleconference and was attended by the tenant only.

Issue(s) to be Decided

The issues to be decided are whether the landlord is entitled to an order of possession for landlord's use or for the tenant breaching an agreement with the landlord; to a monetary order for compensation for damage or loss and to recover the filing fee from the tenant for the cost of the Application for Dispute Resolution, pursuant to Sections 44, 49, 55, 67, and 72 of the Residential Tenancy Act (Act).

Conclusion

In the absence of the applicant landlord, I dismiss this application in its entirety, without leave to reapply.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
