<u>Introduction</u>

This matter was conducted by way of Direct Request Proceeding, pursuant to section 55(4) of the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the "Act"), and dealt with an Application for Dispute Resolution by the landlord for an Order of Possession and a Monetary Order for unpaid rent.

The landlord submitted a signed Proof of Service of the Notice of Direct Request Proceeding to declare that on an unspecified date the landlord served the tenant with the Notice of Direct Request Proceeding via personal delivery.

I find the Proof of Service of the Notice of Direct Request is not sufficiently complete in order for me to conclude the tenant was served with the required documents. Therefore, the landlord's application is dismissed with leave to reapply.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the Residential Tenancy Act.
