Introduction

This hearing dealt with the landlord's Application for Dispute Resolution seeking an order of possession.

The hearing was conducted via teleconference and was attended by two agents for the landlord and the tenant.

Issue(s) to be Decided

The issues to be decided are whether the landlord is entitled to an order of possession for cause and to recover the filing fee from the tenant for the cost of the Application for Dispute Resolution, pursuant to Sections 47, 55, 67, and 72 of the *Residential Tenancy Act (Act)*.

Background and Evidence

Prior to the hearing the parties came to a settlement agreement:

- 1. The landlord withdraws their Application for Dispute Resolution
- 2. The tenant agrees to vacate no later than 12:00 on August 31, 2011.

Conclusion

I accept the above noted settlement agreement and grant the landlord an order of possession in support of the agreement.
