Introduction

This matter dealt with an application by the Landlord for compensation for damages to the rental unit, to recover the filing fee for this proceeding and to keep the Tenant's security deposit and pet damage deposit in partial payment of those amounts.

The oral hearing via teleconference started at 11:00 a.m. as scheduled however by 11:10 a.m. neither party had dialled into the conference call. As there has been no hearing into the merits of the Landlord's application, it is dismissed with leave to reapply *within the time limits set out under s. 60 of the Act.*

Conclusion

The Landlord's application is dismissed with leave to reapply. This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
