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Introduction

This matter was originally conducted by way of Direct Request proceeding. The landlord applied for an order of possession. The Dispute Resolution Officer who conducted the Direct Request proceeding determined that it was appropriate for the matter to be conducted by way of teleconference hearing. I was assigned and conducted a teleconference hearing on this application.

The tenant did not attend the teleconference hearing. At the outset of the hearing, the landlord stated that an order of possession was no longer required, as the tenant had moved out.

Conclusion

The application of the landlord is dismissed.
