DECISION

Dispute Codes OPR, MNR, MNDC, MNSD, FF

This is an application filed by the Landlord for an order of possession resulting from a 10 day notice to end tenancy for unpaid rent, a monetary order request for unpaid rent, for money owed or compensation for damage or loss under the Act, regulation or tenancy agreement, to keep all or part of the pet damage or security deposit and recovery of the filing fee.

Both parties attended the hearing by conference call and gave testimony.

Section 63 of the Act provides that the parties may attempt to settle their dispute during a hearing. Pursuant to this provision, discussion between the parties during the hearing led to a resolution. Specifically, it was agreed as follows:

Both parties agree that the Tenant shall make payment of \$625.00 to the Landlord and the Landlord shall receive a monetary order to reflect this agreement.

the above particulars comprise <u>full and final settlement</u> of all aspects of the dispute arising from this application for both parties.
