DECISION ON REQUEST FOR CORRECTION

Dispute Codes: FF MNSD OLC

The applicant has requested a correction to a decision of the Residential Tenancy Branch dated November 15, 2011.

Section 78 of Residential Tenancy Act enables the Residential Tenancy Branch to:
