<u>Introduction</u>

This is the Tenant's application for an Order that the Landlord comply with the Act, regulation or tenancy agreement; for an Order that the Landlord return the Tenant's personal property; for an Order suspending or setting conditions on the Landlord's right to enter the rental unit; and to recover the cost of the filing fee from the Landlord.

Preliminary Matters

This application was scheduled to be heard via teleconference on January 24, 2012 at 3:00 p.m. The Landlord signed into the Hearing on time and was ready to proceed. At 3:10 p.m., the Tenant/Applicant had still not signed into the teleconference.
