INTERIM DECISION

Dispute Codes MND, MNSD and FF

Introduction

At the commencement of this hearing, the tenants' daughter stated that her parents had been unable to attend the hearing due to a death in the family.

The landlord stated that the tenants' daughter had communicated with him prior to the hearing, made explanation of the circumstances and sought his consent for an adjournment. The landlord gave full consent.

Therefore, this matter is adjourned to a time and date set out in the attached notice of hearing.
