SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

<u>Introduction</u>

This hearing dealt with an Application for Dispute Resolution by the tenant for a monetary order for return of the security deposit and pet deposit.

Both parties appeared, gave affirmed testimony and were provided the opportunity to present their evidence orally and in written and documentary form, and to cross-examine the other party, and make submissions to me.

Settlement Agreement

During the hearing, the parties agreed to settle this matter, on the following conditions:

- 1) The landlord agrees to return the pet deposit in the amount of \$600.00 to the tenant. The landlord will issue a cheque in that amount and send by registered mail, no later than February 10, 2012.
- 2) The parties agree that the tenant did not pay rent for October 2011. The parties agree that the landlord may retain the tenant's security deposit in the amount of \$600.00 as full and final settlement for October 2011, rent.

Residential Tenancy Act.
