Introduction

This matter was convened in response to an application under the *Residential Tenancy Act (the Act)* by the tenant seeking permission to keep a cat, contrary to a term of the contractual tenancy agreement and in the absence of permission by the landlord.

Both parties attended the conference call hearing.

Issue(s) to be Decided

Does the tenant's application seek a remedy to a dispute respecting the rights and obligations under the terms of the tenancy agreement that are required or prohibited under the Act?

Background and Evidence

The parties entered into a tenancy agreement in June of 2010. The tenant and landlord provided document evidence and testimony in respect to the tenant's request to keep a cat despite a term of the tenancy agreement prohibiting a cat; and, the landlord's response turning down the tenant's request to allow a cat. The tenant has not obtained a cat, but claims they may in the future. The landlord is not aware of a breach of the tenancy agreement in this matter. The landlord has not given the tenant a Notice to End respecting any breaches.

Analysis

I find that the landlord has not contravened a right of the tenant or imposed an obligation on the tenant that is required, or prohibited under the Act. I find that I have not been presented with evidence of a breach of the tenancy agreement or of a right, or of an obligation required or prohibited under the Act. I find that the tenant has not presented a dispute which could give rise to a remedy in respect to a right or an obligation under the terms of the tenancy agreement that are required or prohibited

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under the Act. As a result of all the foregoing, I dismiss the tenant's application without leave to reapply. The tenant is at liberty to seek resolution respecting matters impacting the tenant's rights or entitlements under the Act.

Conclusion

I dismiss the application, without leave to reapply.
