Introduction

This matter was scheduled for a direct request proceeding, pursuant to section 55(4) of the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the "*Act*"), and dealt with an application for dispute resolution by the landlord for an order of possession and a monetary order for unpaid rent.

The landlord submitted an illegible copy of the tenancy agreement. A second copy was submitted, however, both of the tenancy agreements received by the Residential Tenancy Branch are not legible. One of the requirements for a direct request proceeding is a legible copy of the tenancy agreement. Both copies of the tenancy agreement provided are not legible, specifically; the details of the monthly rent cannot be read.

Conclusion

Due to the illegible copies of tenancy agreement provided, I dismiss the application for a direct request proceeding with leave to reapply.

This decision is final and binding on the parties, unless otherwise provided under the *Act*, and is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
