<u>Introduction</u>

This is an application filed by the Landlord for an order of possession for the Tenant to

comply with the fixed term tenancy ending and the recovery of the filing fee.

Both parties attended the hearing by conference call and gave affirmed testimony. As

both parties attended the hearing I am satisfied that the Tenant was properly served

with the notice of hearing and evidence package by the Landlord.

Section 63 of the Act provides that the parties may attempt to settle their dispute during

a hearing. Pursuant to this provision, discussion between the parties during the hearing

led to a resolution. Specifically, it was agreed as follows:

Both parties agree to mutually end the tenancy on August 31, 2012 at or before

1:00 pm and that the Landlord shall receive an order of possession to reflect this

agreement.

The above particulars comprise full and final settlement of all aspects of the dispute

arising from this application for both parties.
