DECISION

Introduction and Analysis

This hearing was convened as the result of the tenant's application for dispute resolution under the Residential Tenancy Act (the "Act") seeking cancellation of a Notice to End Tenancy, for a monetary order for a return of his security deposit, and to recover the filing fee for this application.

The conference call hearing started at 9:00 a.m. as scheduled; however by 9:11 a.m., the tenant had not dialled into the hearing to present his claim.

The landlord and his translator appeared and announced they were ready to proceed.

Conclusion

In the absence of the applicant/tenant, I therefore dismiss the tenant's application, without leave to reapply.
