<u>Introduction</u>

This hearing was convened by way of conference call in response to the tenants application for to cancel a Notice to End Tenancy for unpaid rent and to recover the filing fee from the landlord for the cost of this application.

At the outset of the hearing the tenant stated that he and his brother are moving from the rental unit and the parties came to an agreement in this matter.

This agreement is as follows:

The tenants agree to vacate the rental unit by Noon on Monday 30, July, 2012.
