DECISION

<u>Dispute Codes</u> MNR, OPR, FF

<u>Introduction</u>

This hearing was convened to deal with the landlord's application for dispute resolution under the Residential Tenancy Act (the "Act") for an order of possession, for a monetary order for unpaid rent and for recovery of the filing fee.

The landlord appeared, however the tenant did not.

Background and Evidence

At the hearing, the landlord said that the parties had resolved the issues contained in the landlord's application and that the landlord no longer wanted to proceed with his application.

The landlord agreed that his application should be dismissed.

Conclusion

I therefore dismiss the landlord's application and make no findings on the merits of the application.
