Introduction

This telephone conference call hearing was scheduled in response to the landlord's application for an order of possession / a monetary order as compensation for unpaid rent / retention of the security deposit / and recovery of the filing fee. The landlord and counsel were present at the scheduled start time of the hearing which was 9:00 a.m. The tenants did not appear.
