RECORD OF SETTLEMENT

<u>Dispute Codes</u> MNDC, MNSD, O, MNR

Section 63 of the *Residential Tenancy Act* provides that the parties may attempt to settle their dispute during a hearing. Pursuant to this provision, discussion between the parties during the hearing led to a resolution. Specifically, it was agreed as follows;

1. Both parties agree that the landlord will pay the tenant \$729.69 on or before October 9, 2012.

The above particulars comprise <u>full and final settlement</u> of all aspects of the dispute arising from this application including all matters related to the security deposit and the tenancy itself for both parties.

Pursuant to this agreement the tenant will be given a monetary order to reflect condition #1 of this agreement. Should it be necessary, this order may be filed in the Small Claims Division of the Provincial Court.
