<u>Introduction</u>

This is an application filed by the Landlord for an order of possession and a monetary

order for unpaid rent.

Both parties attended the hearing by conference call and gave testimony.

Section 63 of the Act provides that the parties may attempt to settle their dispute during

a hearing. Pursuant to this provision, discussion between the parties during the hearing

led to a resolution. Specifically, it was agreed as follows:

Both parties mutually agreed that the Tenant make payment of \$3,000.00 for

past rent arrears and November rent on or before November 5, 2012 at 8:00 pm. Both

parties further agree that if the Tenant fails to make this payment or come to a mutual

agreement that the Landlord is entitled to reapply for an order of possession based

upon this settlement.

The above particulars comprise full and final settlement of all aspects of the dispute

arising from this application for both parties.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential
