Introduction and Analysis

This telephone conference call hearing was convened as the result of the landlord's application for dispute resolution under the Residential Tenancy Act (the "Act") seeking a monetary order for damage to the rental unit, for authority to retain the tenant's security deposit and for recovery of the filing fee.

The hearing began at 9:00 a.m. as scheduled and the telephone system remained open and was monitored for 10 minutes. During this time, neither the applicant/landlord nor the respondent/tenant dialed into the telephone conference call hearing.

Conclusion

In the absence of the landlord to present his claim, I therefore dismiss the landlord's application, with leave to reapply.

I make no findings on the merits of the application. Leave to reapply is not an extension of any applicable limitation period.
