# **DECISION**

#### <u>Introduction</u>

This hearing was held in response to the tenant's Application for Dispute Resolution in which the tenant has applied to cancel a 10 Day Notice to End Tenancy for Unpaid Rent, compensation for damage or loss in the sum of \$200.00, an Order the landlord comply with the Act, an Order the landlord complete repairs and that the tenant be allowed to reduce rent owed.

The landlord attended the hearing at the scheduled start time of 9 a.m. By 9:10 a.m. the tenant had not entered the conference call hearing.

The Rules of Procedure provides:

# Commencement of the dispute resolution proceeding

The dispute resolution proceeding must commence at the scheduled time unless otherwise decided by the Dispute Resolution Officer. The Dispute Resolution Officer may conduct the dispute resolution proceeding in the absence of a party and may make a decision or dismiss the application, with or without leave to re-apply.

In the absence of an appearance by the tenant, his application is abandoned and dismissed.

This decision is final and binding on the parties, unless otherwise provided under the Act, and is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the Residential Tenancy Act.
