Introduction

This matter was conducted by way of Direct Request Proceeding, pursuant to section 55(4) of the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the "Act"), and dealt with an Application for Dispute Resolution by the landlord for an Order of Possession and a Monetary Order for unpaid rent.

The landlord submitted an unsigned and undated Proof of Service of the Notice of Direct Request Proceeding. The Proof of Service does not indicate the name of the tenant, the date or time service occurred, or the method of service.

Based on the above, I find the landlord has not provided sufficient evidence that the tenant has been served with the Notice of Direct Request Proceeding as required. Therefore, the landlord's application is dismissed with leave to reapply.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
