DECISION

Dispute Codes MNSD, OPR, OPL, OPB, MNR, MND, MNDC, FF

Introduction and Analysis

This telephone conference call hearing was convened as the result of the landlord's application for dispute resolution under the Residential Tenancy Act (the "Act") for an order of possession for the rental unit, a monetary order for unpaid rent, damage to the rental unit, and money owed or compensation for damage or loss, for authority to retain the tenant's security deposit and to recover the filing fee.

The hearing began at 9:00 a.m. as scheduled and the telephone system remained open and was monitored for 10 minutes. During this time, neither the applicants/landlords nor the respondents/tenants dialed into the telephone conference call hearing.

Conclusion

In the absence of the landlords to present their claim, pursuant to section 10.1 of the Residential Tenancy Branch Rules of Procedure (Rules), I dismiss the landlords' application, without leave to reapply.
