DECISION

Introduction:

The tenants have made a monetary claim for double the security deposit.

Facts:

Both parties attended a conference call hearing. A tenancy began on May 1, 2012 with rent in the amount of \$1,225.00 due in advance on the first day of each month. The tenants paid a security deposit totalling \$600.00 on May 2012. The tenants moved out on March 31, 2013 in breach of their fixed term tenancy agreement.

Settlement:

The parties settled this matter and they have asked that I record the agreement pursuant to section 63(2) as follows:

- a. In satisfaction for all claims the landlord and tenant now have or may have arising from this tenancy the parties agree that the landlord will be permitted to retain the sum of \$ 300.00 from the tenants' security deposit,
- b. The parties agree that the landlord shall pay the tenants the balance of their security deposit which together with interest totals \$ 300.00, and
- c. In consideration for this mutual settlement the parties agree that no further claims will be made by either party whatsoever arising from this tenancy.

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Conclusion:

As a result of the settlement I ordered that the landlord retain the sum of \$ 300.00 from

the security deposit and I granted the tenants a monetary Order in the amount of

\$ 300.00 effective July 15, 2013. This order may be filed in the Small Claims Court and

enforced as an order of that Court. There shall be no order as to reimbursement of the

filing fee. I have dismissed all other claims made by the tenants.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential

Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the Residential Tenancy Act.
