DECISION

Dispute Codes OPR, MNR, MNSD and FF

Introduction

This hearing was convened on an application made by the landlord on May 24, 2013 seeking an Order of Possession pursuant to a 10-day Notice to End Tenancy for unpaid rent served by posting on the tenant's door on May 2, 2013. The landlord also sought a Monetary Order for the unpaid rent, recovery of the filing fee for this proceeding and authorization to retain the security deposit in set off against the balance owed.

The hearing convened at 11 a.m. on June 18, 2013 as scheduled and was held open for 10 minutes; however, neither party called in to the number provided to enable their participation in the telephone conference call proceeding.

Therefore, in the absence of both parties, the application is dismissed with leave to reapply.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
