## RECORD OF SETTLEMENT

<u>Dispute Codes</u> RP, CNC, MNDC, FF

Section 63 of the *Residential Tenancy Act* provides that the parties may attempt to settle their dispute during a hearing. Pursuant to this provision, discussion between the parties during the hearing led to a resolution. Specifically, it was agreed as follows;

- 1. Both parties agree that the tenant will move out by no later than 1:00 p.m. on October 31, 2013.
- 2. Both parties agree that the landlord will provide a working washing machine for the tenant by no later than July 17, 2013.
- 3. Both parties agree that the landlord will have a repairman come to inspect and conduct any necessary repairs to the patio deck by no later than July 17, 2013.

Pursuant to this agreement the landlord will be given an order of possession to reflect condition #1 of this agreement. Should it be necessary, this order may be filed in the Supreme Court and enforced as an order of that Court.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
