<u>Introduction</u>

This hearing was held in response to the tenant's Application for Dispute Resolution in which the tenants have applied to cancel a 2 Month Notice to End Tenancy for Landlord's Use.

This matter was set for hearing at 9 a.m. on this date. The applicants and respondent failed to attend the hearing by 9:10 a.m. The Residential Tenancy Branch Rules of Procedure, section 10.1, provides:

Commencement of the dispute resolution proceeding

The dispute resolution proceeding must commence at the scheduled time unless otherwise decided by the Dispute Resolution Officer. The Dispute Resolution Officer may conduct the dispute resolution proceeding in the absence of a party and may make a decision or dismiss the application, with or without leave to reapply.

In the absence of an appearance by either party by 9:10 a.m., this application is abandoned and dismissed with leave to reapply within the legislated time-frames.
