DECISION

Dispute Codes OPR, MNR, MNSD, OPC, MNDC, FF

Introduction

This hearing dealt with the landlord's application for dispute resolution under the Residential Tenancy Act (the "Act") seeking a monetary order for money owed or compensation for damage or loss and unpaid rent, an order of possession for the rental unit due to unpaid rent, an order of possession for the rental unit due to alleged cause, for authority to retain the tenant's security deposit, and for recovery of the filing fee.

The landlord appeared; the tenant did not appear.

At the outset of the hearing, the landlord confirmed that the tenant has vacated the rental unit; therefore the landlord no longer required an order of possession for the rental unit.

In response to my question the landlord also stated that she did not wish to pursue the monetary claim listed in her application and that she wanted to close the file.

The landlord therefore requested that her application be withdrawn.

<u>Analysis</u>

The landlord requested to withdraw her application at this time. As no findings of fact or law have been made I grant the landlord's request for withdrawal of her application, with leave to reapply.

Conclusion

The application has been withdrawn, with leave to reapply.
