Introduction

This hearing was convened as a result of the tenant's application for dispute resolution seeking remedy under the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the "Act"). The tenant applied to cancel a 10 Day Notice to End Tenancy for Unpaid Rent or Utilities and "other" although details of "other" were not clear in the tenant's application.

The tenant and the landlord attended the hearing. The tenant stated that she vacated the rental unit since filing her application, which the landlord confirmed, and requested to **withdraw her application in full**. Therefore, I make no findings on the merits of the matter.

The tenant is at liberty to reapply. This decision does not extend any applicable time limits under the *Act*.

This decision is final and binding on the parties, unless otherwise provided under the *Act*, and is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
