DECISION

Introduction

The tenant applies to cancel a ten day Notice to End Tenancy and for more time to make the application.

Neither party attended for the hearing of this matter. The application is therefore dismissed. As s. 66(3) of the *Residential Tenancy Act* prohibits the extension of time to make an application to challenge a Notice to End Tenancy passed the effective date of the Notice, I do not grant leave for the tenant to re-apply.
