DECISION

<u>Dispute Codes</u> CNC, FF

Introduction

The tenants apply to cancel a one month Notice to End Tenancy served July 12, 2013 with an effective end of tenancy date of August 31, 2013.

The parties were able to reach a settlement of this matter as follows:

- 1. The landlord will have an immediate order of possession against the tenants but the landlord will not proceed to serve and enforce the order unless:
 - i) The tenants fail to pay August rent of \$950.00 on or before August 31, 2013, or
 - ii) The tenants fail to pay September rent of \$950.00 on or before September 2, 2013, or
 - iii) The tenants fail to vacate the premises on or before one o'clock in the afternoon on September 30, 2013.
- 2. The landlord may proceed to show the premises to prospective tenants for October 1 2013, but must give the tenants at least two hours notice of doing so by calling or leaving a message at (778) 869-2764 or, if no answer, then calling or leaving a message at (778) 927-0709.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the Residential Tenancy Act.
