<u>Introduction</u>

This hearing was convened in response to an Application for Dispute Resolution, in which the Tenant applied for the return of the security deposit and to recover the filing fee from the Landlord for the cost of filing this application.

Issue(s) to be Decided

Is the Tenant entitled to the return of the security deposit?

Background and Evidence

The hearing was scheduled for 10:30 a.m. on this date and by 10:41 a.m. the Landlord had appeared, but the Tenant had not appeared.

Analysis

I find that the Tenant failed to diligently pursue the application and I therefore dismiss the application without leave to reapply.
